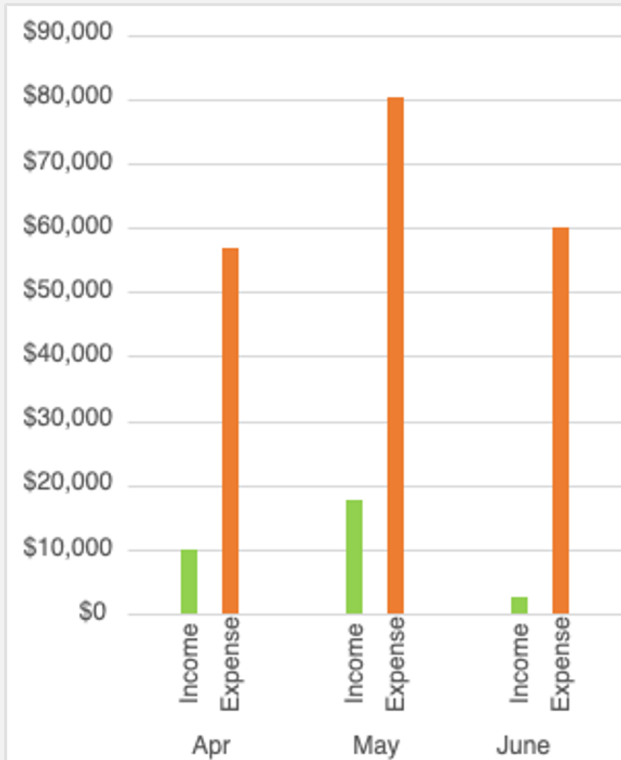




# Q2-2022 (April-June) Report

## Financial Information



- Expenses (building expenses, salaries, programs) ranged from \$55k/mo to \$80k/mo (Ramadan)
- Donations from the general community (shown as income) ranged from \$17k/mo (Ramadan) to less than \$3k/mo (June) resulting in large deficits, which are currently being covered by special donations
- This means that each person in the general community donated a little over **one dollar** per Jumma attended in June
- **We need donations of \$20 per person attending Jumma (\$100/month) to cover the deficit**

## Activities

### Community Assistance

- Pre-Ramadan distribution for 290 families and individuals
- Zakat-ul-Fitr distribution for 60 families and individuals
- Ramadan feeding for 100 people/night in last 10 nights
- Rent/utilities/scholarship/funeral assistance of approximately \$20k

### Community Engagement

- Held Qiyam for youth on 27<sup>th</sup> night of Ramadan with more than 70 youth attending
- Started RC Fridays focused on pre-teen and teens which is averaging 70+ attendees each
- Started New Muslims support group

### Education

- Held workshop with Sh. Suhaib Webb
- Held 8 Week Women's education series and workshop with Dr. Sh. Haifaa Younis
- Sent survey regarding Quran Classes. Designing classes to start in the fall

### Religious

- Held first Ramadan Taraweeh prayers
- Hired full-time Imam to start in August
- Started pre-teen and teen programs
