SCOPE

Serves as a teacher and is responsible for teaching students at the Quran institute and assist the Imam as needed. Reports directly to the Imam.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teaching the Arabic alphabet (Qaidah Nooraniyah) and recitation of the Quran with rules of Tajweed and Makharij.
- Must be able to teach all ages (6-18 years of age).
- Integrate Islamic teachings, morals, and values into lesson plans and instruction.
- Participate in ongoing training and Islamic learning and development sessions.
- Evaluate each student and create teaching strategies based on the student's level.
- Working hours are: Tuesdays and Thursdays: 4:05 PM – 7:05 PM.

Knowledge/Education

- Fluency in English. Other languages are a plus.
- Sound knowledge and implementation of the rules of Tajweed is required.
- Teacher certification is a plus.
- Have an Ijazah or Certificate from a recognized Institute is a plus.

Skills & Abilities

- Effectively uses technology to enhance instruction.
- Ability to effectively manage a classroom and student behavior.
- Developing a positive relationship with the students within the Islamic guidelines.

Experience
