Financial Report



- Extra payroll period plus one-time expenses caused spike in Mar expenses.

Activity Report Community Assistance

- Rent/utilities/scholarship/funeral assistance of approximately \$22k
- Zakat and Eid al-Adha distribution for 357 families/individuals for \$124k
- Provided financial aid to QI attendees
- Counseling program: Team of 16 therapists provided 496 hours of therapy for 117 clients, in Individual, Marital, Family/Parenting areas. Pre-marital counseling services started with Divorce Mediation services to be introduced.
