Earlier this year, Sh. Atef started focusing on the Education role, which has now resulted in the ongoing development and deployment of Rahma Academy, in addition to the growing Quran Institute and enhanced group class offerings. We are happy to announce that Sr. Mubashera has taken on the role of leading Rahma Academy's development. There will be significant growth in services as the physical counseling offices come online as part of the Phase 2 construction. As you are aware, Phase 2 will encompass over 100,000 square feet of operational space versus the approximately 15,000 square feet that we use today. With that in mind, we will begin the search for a new Operations Director, which we hope to conclude by Ramadan 2024, Insha Allah. Until a new leader is found and the work is transitioned, Br. Issa will continue to serve as Operations Director for Rahma Center, while evaluating other opportunities inside and outside of Rahma Center. We pray that Allah (SWT) guides all of us and makes this Center a source of Rahma for everyone. Ameen.


