O Allah, we seek refuge in You from being deceived by Your forbearance, from transgressing Your limits, and from taking Your commands and prohibitions lightly—O Lord of the worlds.

Our Lord, You softened the hearts of our parents toward us when we were small, and You increased Your blessings upon us as we grew older. You sent us continuous kindness and delayed punishment though we deserved it—so do not expose us on the Day of Resurrection, making us a disgrace among the people. Do not shame us with our sins, causing us humiliation and heartbreak.

Our Lord, these crowds have come to You from all directions, striving to stand before You humbly. They bow their heads to Your majesty, kneel before Your glory, and fall in prostration before You. They raise their hands in supplication, awaiting relief from You—so give us and them glad tidings of immediate relief.

They ask You for healing—so heal us and heal them, and heal our sick and theirs, and the sick among the Muslims.

They ask You for forgiveness for their deceased—O Allah, forgive our dead and theirs, and the dead of all the Muslims.

They hope for the righteousness of their affairs, their children, and their wealth—so grant us and them rectitude.

They seek Your mercy which encompasses everything—so have mercy on us and on them.

They long for their necks to be freed—so free our necks and theirs from the Hellfire.

O Allah, there are among us those with needs, desires, prayers, and pleas—O Owner of the heavens and the earth—fulfill our needs and theirs.

Return us tonight to our homes while You are pleased with us, having drawn us near, forgiven us, freed us, granted us, healed us, provided for us, covered us, pleased us, lifted our burdens, and fulfilled our hopes.

Our Lord, Your generosity never ends, nor does Your giving cease. Your hand is full of goodness, giving and bestowing as You will.

O Lord of this blessed night, grant us from Your gifts and bless us with a life of contentment and tranquility.

O Allah, You made us love closeness to You through the freeing of slaves. We are Your servants—poor, weak—and You are most worthy of grace and emancipation. So free our necks from the Hellfire.

O Allah, we testify that we are not fit for the Hellfire. We cannot bear trials, poverty, or illness. But if there are people worthy of Your forgiveness and well-being—then make us among them, and do not separate us from them.

O You who said: "Say, each acts according to his disposition"—our disposition is sin and shortcoming, but Yours is pardon and ease.

O You who are known for Your kindness, O You who are described with the best of attributes, O Allah, You are Most Forgiving and love forgiveness, so forgive us. Forgive us, O Generous One. Forgive us, O Merciful One. Forgive

our parents, our spouses, our children, our brothers and sisters, our loved ones, and all who asked us to pray for them or trusted us with their prayers.

O Allah, grant us from Your forgiveness, Your pardon, Your wellness, Your provision, and Your covering—blessings no eye has seen, no ear has heard, and that never crossed a human heart.

O Allah, fulfill for us all the good we asked for—what we remembered and what we forgot, what we declared and what we kept within.

O Allah, have mercy—mercy—for the Muslims. Mercy—mercy—for the Muslims.

O Allah, transfer them from hardship to ease, from misery to happiness, from affliction to well-being, from fear to safety, and bring them back to You and to Your religion.
