O Allah, cool its heat, erase its effects, and remove from us its harm and its pain.

O Allah, protect us from whispers and harmful thoughts, from the temptations of Shayṭān and from sickness, from

sleeplessness and disturbing dreams. O Possessor of Majesty and Honor.

O Allah, Lord of the pure and righteous, rectify the women of the Muslims, especially our families and those present among us. Forgive their sins, multiply their good deeds, and make them guides who are guided — pure and uplifting, content and pleasing to You, protected from the devils among humans and jinn.

Make them honored through their modesty, their covering, and their dignity. Let them take pride in their faith. Protect them from harmful companionship and bad influences, and grant them righteous friends who sincerely advise and support them. O Creator of the heavens and the earth.

O Allah, make them a source of comfort for their faith, for their parents, for their husbands, for their sons and daughters. Make them, our Lord, a beautiful example for their families.

O Allah, place in their hearts a love for modesty and the love of ḥijāb.

Our Lord, whoever among them protects herself and guards her modesty, then cover her, O Allah — cover her above the earth, cover her beneath the earth, and cover her on the Day when all will stand before You.

O Allah, protect them from anything that would bring Your anger or displeasure. Protect them from immodesty, from deception, and from every form of evil. O Mighty, O Most Forgiving.

Our Lord, accept the repentance of those who turn back to You. Accept those who have sinned and now seek forgiveness. Accept those who apologize and return to You. Overlook the mistakes of those who slipped. Heal the sick among them, grant children to those who cannot conceive, provide spouses for those who are single, relieve the worries of those who are distressed, and keep firm those who are righteous and striving to do good.

Our Lord, just as You bring the clouds together, bring harmony between every husband and wife. And just as You made the sea submit to Your Prophet Mūsā, make their husbands gentle and cooperative with them, and make them gentle with their husbands. And just as You softened iron for Your Prophet Dāwūd, make them gentle, kind, pleasant, and obedient with their parents and spouses. O You who answer prayers.

O Allah, make our homes and the homes of all Muslims peaceful homes — filled with the Qur'an and filled with Your pleasure, O Most Merciful. Make them places of safety, love,

and warmth. Do not make them places where Shayṭān finds comfort, feeding, and rest. By Your mercy, O Most Merciful of those who show mercy.

O Allah, keep our homes away from insults, conflict, and divorce. Keep them under Your protection and well-being. Remove from them Your anger and shower them with Your blessings. Do not allow our enemies, the jealous, or those who harbor hatred to rejoice over us.

O Allah, make us love acts of obedience, and allow our sons and daughters to grow beautifully in goodness and righteousness. O Giver of endless goodness and great gifts.

O Allah, gather our families, those present here, those listening, and all Muslim women together with the pure wives of Your Prophet in the highest levels of Paradise. O You who answer every supplication.

O Allah, whoever feels distant from their home, overwhelmed by their children or spouse, or disconnected from their relatives, remove their hardship. Place love in their hearts for their homes and families. Bring harmony between them and their spouses. Restore their relationships with their relatives through Your mercy, O Most Merciful.

O Allah, accept our fasting, our prayers at night, our supplications, and all our deeds. Do not leave among us or

around us anyone who is miserable, deprived, rejected, or turned away from Your mercy.

O Allah, You are the Most Pardoning, and You love to pardon — so pardon us.

O Allah, make us among those You free from the Hellfire.

Protect us from Your Fire and grant us the wide gardens of Your Paradise, O Most Merciful of those who show mercy.

O Allah, allow this month to end for us with Your pleasure, with forgiveness and acceptance, with generosity and mercy, and with freedom from the Fire.

O Allah, keep Your blessings upon us, place barakah in our days and nights, grant us sincerity in our words and actions, and let our lives end with the best of endings.

O Allah, gather us in this life upon Your obedience, and gather us in the next life in the gardens of Your Paradise with those we love and hope to be with — with Your chosen Prophet, with his family, his companions, and all those who follow his path.

And may Allah send His peace, blessings, and mercy upon our Prophet Muhammad, and upon his family and all his companions.
